Reviewing 2003

• UNC finished 40-22-1, reaching the 40-wins mark for the sixth time in school history and the third time in the last three years. The Tar Heels went 4-3 in Atlantic Coast Conference play to finish second in the regular season.

• The Tar Heels reached the NCAA Tournament for the second time in three years, playing in Fresno, Calif. There, Carolina went 1-2, opening with a 9-1 loss to Michigan State then beating Long Island 10-2 before being eliminated by Fresno State 2-0.

Tar Heels vs. ranked teams

North Carolina's 2003 schedule included 14 games against teams ranked in the nation's top 25, including five ranked in the top 10. The Tar Heels scored a pair of wins in those games, defeating No. 19 Michigan 3-1 at the Texas Invitational on March 1 and beating No. 9 Georgia 2-1 in eight innings on April 19 on the Bulldogs' home field.

The win over Georgia was particularly dramatic. With the Tar Heels playing as the home team, senior Quinn Porter hit a two-out, two-run homer to end the game after Georgia scored a run in the top of the eighth.
