Carolina Softball History

North Carolina's varsity softball program got its first season off to a victorious start on March 23, 1977, with a 15-6 win over N.C. Central. After UNC offered softball as a club sport in 1976, a varsity team was formed in 1977 and the Tar Heels finished the season with a record of 13-18, one of only three times in school history that Carolina has posted a final season record below .500.

Progress was swift, however, and by 1981 the team was competing for a national championship. The Tar Heels won the AIAW Southern Region II Tournament that year and finished second to Florida State at the AIAW National Slow-Pitch Tournament, which was held in Raleigh.

UNC switched to fastpitch play in 1984 and compiled a record of 26-14 that year, despite the fact that the roster included only six players who had fastpitch experience. One of those six was freshman pitcher Virginia Augusta, who threw two no-hitters in '84 and went on to set numerous program records. As a senior, she led the team with a 20-5-1 record and an ERA of 0.54. She still holds several UNC records, including career winning percentage (.747) and fewest runs allowed (75).

Under coach Susan Clark, 1984 also was the year the Tar Heels moved to Finley Field, their home until 2002. In its early years as a program, the team played most of its home games at James Field, which was located on the southern part of the campus, near where the Dean E. Smith Center now stands.

In 1986 Donna Papa, formerly the softball and volleyball coach at Susquehanna University, took over as coach of the Tar Heels. She has guided the team to 16 winning seasons in her 18 years in Chapel Hill. She enters her 19th UNC campaign with a record of 634-381-4 as the Tar Heel coach, 663-396-4 in 20 seasons as a head coach.

Although the Tar Heels previously had faced some Atlantic Coast Conference teams, UNC officially began league play in 1992, along with Florida State, Georgia Tech and Virginia. (Maryland has since joined the ranks and NC State will field a team beginning in 2004.) It did not take

Carolina long to start earning conference honors. In 1994, the Tar Heels had their first ACC Player of the Year when Beverly Smith batted .346 and led Carolina with 36 RBIs to earn the honor. Brandy Arthur followed her in 1998, and Michelle Semmes won as a junior in 2000.

Papa has been named conference Coach of the Year three times, in 1996, '98 and 2000, when Carolina finished with its best record in the history of the fastpitch program. The 2000 Tar Heels finished 47-17 and set team records for hits, runs, RBI, doubles, home runs and total bases.

The 2001 Tar Heels reached two milestones that had been long-time program goals. On May 13, 2001, UNC won its first ACC Tournament, defeating Florida State 4-1 in the title game to claim the conference championship. Later that day, UNC received an at-large bid to the NCAA Tournament. In their first tournament appearance, the Tar Heels finished 1-2 in the NCAA Regional at Norman, Okla.

The following season, Carolina celebrated another landmark when the team moved into its new facility, the UNC Softball Complex. After many years of planning, the team now competes on one of the nation's finest fields.

For the second time in as many years, the Tar Heels reached the ACC Championship game in 2002, this time finishing as the runner-up. UNC set many milestones in the 2002 season including school records in at-bats, home runs and RBIs.

In 2003, Carolina again earned an NCAA Regional bid and traveled to Fresno, Calif., where the Tar Heels went 1-2. For the first time in program history, UNC had two players earn All-America honors, with Tolleson and freshman Jaelyn Holden both named to the third team.
